## Bronze Level



Kids:	50 to 74 hours
Young Adults:	100 to 174 hours
Adults:	100 to 249 hours
Family & Groups:	200 to 499 hours

## Silver Level



Kids:	75 to 99 hours
Young Adults:	175 to 249 hours
Adults:	250 to 499 hours
Family & Groups:	500 to 999 hours

## Gold Level



Kids:	100 hours or more
Young Adults:	250 hours or more
Adults:	500 hours or more
Family & Groups:	1000 hours or more

### How to set up a volunteer account:

1. Go to [www.presidentialserviceawards.gov](http://www.presidentialserviceawards.gov)
2. Click on the "Track Your Hours" tab.
3. Create a profile using your email address and a password.
4. Once your account is created, you will be directed to your volunteer home page.
5. Click on the "Profile" tab.
6. In the box titled "Record of Service Key" enter VJN-59294. This is the library's code so that your volunteer hours will link with the library's Certifying Organization account.

### How to log in volunteer service hours:

1. Go to [www.presidentialserviceawards.gov](http://www.presidentialserviceawards.gov)
2. Click on the LOGIN button in the top right hand corner.
3. Login using your email address and password you created.
4. Log your volunteer hours by clicking on the "My Service" tab and clicking on "Create New Record." Enter the requested information and select "Add this Activity" at the bottom of the page. Your hours will be added to your log.

### Award Criteria:

- Recipients must be a U.S. citizen or lawfully admitted permanent resident of the United States.
- Awards are issued for service hours served within a 12-month time period or over the course of a lifetime.
- Awards are issued for volunteer service only.
- Court-ordered community service does not qualify for the award.
